

# Siena College/Union Graduate College Articulation Agreement

Union Graduate College provides two highly selective programs that prepare students for leadership in business:

- MBA - accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB)
- MBA in Healthcare Management - accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) and the Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Management Education (CAHME)

Union Graduate College has established an articulation agreement with Siena College that allows students to complete their MBA degree in about one additional year after completing their undergraduate program. Students must complete the Siena College courses listed below with a grade of B- or above to waive the Union Graduate College equivalents.

**\*Note: A maximum of 8 courses can be waived. If a 9<sup>th</sup> class is eligible for waiver, it must be replaced with an elective at UGC \***

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

### Juniors (Early Admission):

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester of junior year require a GPA of  $\geq 3.4$  and GMAT of  $\geq 600$

### Seniors (And alumni)

- GPA of  $\geq 3.4$  may waive the GMAT for admission
- Recommended regular admission requirements are  $\geq$ GPA of 3.0/ $\geq$ GMAT of 500

**NOTE: The GMAT is required if you wish to be considered for a scholarship.**
